Investment Facts

Since 1991, Intel Capital has invested US\$12.3 billion in 1,544 companies in 57 countries. In that timeframe, 666 portfolio companies have gone public or participated in a merger.

As of Q3, Intel Capital in 2018 has invested \$212 million in 61 companies, including 24 new companies. Two portfolio companies went IPO and 8 were acquired.

2017 Activity:

- \$690 million invested in 87 companies; 42 new investments and 45 follow on investments
- Lead investor in >60% of new investments
- 22% of investments made in diverse companies
- 10 companies completed IPOs; 26 companies were acquired
